To make your mask:

The mask will be nice and strong if you trace or photocopy this template onto card. It will be fine on paper, just not quite as robust.

You will need:

- scissors
- colouring pencils or crayons
- stapler
- elastic
- bits to decorate
- something to make whiskers

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out the mask shape along the black lines.
- 2. Cut out the eye holes. (All 4 of them!)
- 3. Slide the left side of the mask over the right hand side, until the two arrows line up.
- 4. Now you can see how the mask makes a mouse's face...
- 5. Colour in and decorate the face.
- 6. Staple the mask together, add some whiskers and some elastic to keep it on.
- 7. Wear your mouse mask!
